

Prerequisites:

Strong understanding of the Classical Arabic Language.

Language of Instruction:

Classical Arabic (عربية).

Who It's For:

This program has been designed especially for students that live abroad that are interested in visiting Istanbul to seek Sacred Knowledge.

Details:

Each module will be two-weeks long in which we will be covering two subjects. Applicants will be required to choose two subjects from the table below, according to his level of previous studies.

Students can choose to partake in the program for two weeks, four weeks or six weeks.

Students will cover two subjects at a time, for each module (two-week period). Then they will move on to the next two subjects and so on.

Students of this years program will be encouraged to continue onto further levels of studies and subjects in the upcoming years.

A detailed breakdown of the program will be made available closer to the start of the program.

Logistics:

Lessons will be five-days a week and broken down into four sessions, 90 minutes each. Saturdays and Sundays will be off, but may comprise of activities such as enrichment sessions with teachers and tours to historical sites.

Student housing is not included.

Cost:


Free. A \$200USD Deposit will be required upon acceptance in order to secure your seat. Deposits will be returned to those that successfully complete the program.
